
## TROUBLE SHOOTING

If necessary to do a super-reset of the CCRecorder, to clear any strange condition(s), press-and-hold both the **A** and **C** buttons (All Clear) simultaneously during power-on, until the time is shown on the display. The CCRecorder should return to an idle condition, ready to use again. All recordings and setup times are still preserved on the hard disk.

#### Be Careful, Do you really want to do this?

If necessary to erase ALL the recordings on entire disk, and ALL the **SETUP** Times, press-and-hold the 4 session buttons **E**, **F**, **G**, and **IMMED**. simultaneously during power-on until the time is shown on the display. This restores the Recorder to a "factory-new" condition. Note: All the green lights momentarily illuminate for 1 second as confirmation that the hard disk directory is being re-initialized.



# **GETTING STARTED**

#### Powering Your CCRecorder\_

Before powering your CCRecorder be sure to read the Safety Instructions on page 1. The CCRecorder will run on the supplied 16V AC adapter when powered by 120V AC house current. Before you plug the power supply into the CCRecorder, be sure the AC voltage is 120Volts/60Hz.




On the back of the recorder, insert the plug on the end of the supplied power supply into the AC **POWER IN** jack.

Switch the CCRecorder's rear power **ON/OFF** switch to the '**ON**' position. The CCRecorder will spin-up its hard disk and then will display the time on its red numeric display. If the displayed time is not correct, see next page for directions.

# SETTING MODES \_\_\_\_\_

To set the **EASY** mode, just press the **E** button when the CCRecorder is idle. The display will read "**EASY**" for several seconds. The **EASY** mode is the normal mode of operating. The CCRecorder can be in either mode to set **QUICK SETUP** codes.

To set the **"PRO"** mode, press-and-hold session **F** button for about 4 seconds when the CCRecorder is idle. The display will read **".Pro"** for several seconds, and the small red "decimal-point" light in lower left area of the display will remain on while you remain in the **Pro** mode.

Both the **QUICK SETUP** and **CUSTOM SETUP** times programmed to record or playback work while in either **EASY** or **PRO** modes.

#### Mute/Pause \_\_\_\_\_

To pause the playback, press the MUTE/PAUSE button.

The mute button can be used while recording if you wish to listen to your recording at a later time.

# Auto Restore \_\_\_\_\_

After a power failure, and the eventual return of power, the Recorder will restore itself to whatever it was doing at one second before the power failure. It will return to **RECORD** mode, or **PLAYBACK** mode, if it was in either of those modes immediately prior to the power failure.

# RESET BUTTON\_

The CCRecorder contains a circuit to reliably reset itself whenever the power is switched on. The **RESET** button performs the same function, as removing and re-applying the power without actually turning it off. The **RESET** button just resets the CCRecorder's computer to the beginning state. It does not erase the audio programs or programming from the hard disk.



# ERASE UNWANTED RECORDINGS

To erase the event that is playing back, press-and-hold the **VOL NORM** button for about 3 seconds during playback, until the display shows **ERASED**. The recording is replaced with approx. 2 seconds of silence.

#### Be Careful, Do you really want to do this?

To Erase ALL recordings **QUICK SETUP** and **CUSTOM SETUP** times, switch off the CCRecorder, then switch the CCRecorder on while quickly pressing and holding the **C**, **D**, **E**, **F** buttons (hold down all four keys). Continuing to hold all four session buttons simultaneously down while the CCRecorder is initializing, until the CCRecorder displays the present time as normal.

# PLAYBACK IN REVERSE \_\_\_\_\_


"Double-Clicking" the **MUTE/PAUSE** button during playback of any recording will cause the playback to go IN REVERSE. Time Stamp display will also count backwards when playing in reverse. Playback will also chain events in reverse.

While playback in reverse is being performed press the **VOL NORM** to change the reversal playback speed between normal 100% reverse speed, and a slowed-down 75% reverse speed.

To resume forward-direction playback, double click the **MUTE/PAUSE** button again. If necessary to restore 100% speed, press **VOL NORM** again.

# SELECT AUDIO SOURCE (PRO STATE)

When the CCRecorder is in **Pro** state and idle, press the **DISPLAY** button several times until the display shows "**src rA**" (Radio Line In), use the **ADJUST** button to select "**src AU**" (Aux Line In), or "**src PH**" (Built-In Microphone). While the CCRecorder is idle, before going to custom setup you can switch to any of these



sources to **record** from. To set an audio source other than Radio Line In, for your programmed recording event press **DISPLAY** button while in setup and change to your desired input source.

To avoid microphone squeal while in "**src PH**" mode use headphones in the **External Speaker Out** jack or press the **MUTE** button.

#### SETTING THE CLOCK \_\_\_\_\_

If necessary to correct the time, have the CCRecorder idle, and press the **BACK**<< or **FWD** >> buttons to correct the present time display. Then press the **ADJUST** button to set the AM/PM and the "number" of the day-of-week. The day-of-week is designated as 1 for Monday, 2 for Tuesday, etc. Example: 10:45PM on Friday = 10:45.P5 on the CCRecorder display. Example: 8:37AM on Sunday = 8:37.A7 on the Recorder display.

To see the seconds, press the **DISPLAY** (**Seconds**) button. And, if you know the exact moment when seconds = 00, then press the **ADJUST** button at that exact moment, to snap the seconds display to **00**. Then if the minutes are incorrect, use the **BACK**<< or **FWD** >> buttons again to correct the minutes without disturbing the incrementing of the seconds.

To lock the clock display so the time cannot be changed: with the recorder idle, press and hold the **G** button for about 3 seconds until the display reads "**Loc On**". The clock time cannot be changed until the lock feature is turned off. Turn the lock off by pressing and holding the **G** button again, with the recorder idle, until display reads "**Lock Off**".

#### VOICE PROMPT FEATURE

Press the **DISPLAY** button while recorder is idle to hear the time, day and mode status. Pressing the **DISPLAY** button again, will stop the speech.

While in the playback mode press the **DISPLAY** button to hear the session, level and time stamp. If the **DISPLAY** button is pressed while in setup mode, you will hear session, the time on the display, days to record and recording source.

When setting the quick setup codes, the recorder confirms the number on the display.

To hear an ongoing count of the live seconds, press and hold down the **DISPLAY** button. The Recorder will say "seconds: eighteen, nineteen, twenty-one, etc." until you release the **DISPLAY** button.

# 90 MINUTE SLEEP TIMER\_\_\_\_\_

To activate the 90-minute sleep timer, press-and-hold the **MUTE/PAUSE** button until the "**SLP 90**" message appears momentarily on the display. The small light along the bottom left of the numeric display stays on to indicate the 90-minute sleep timer is active. In 90 minutes, the

CCRecorder will automatically go to a mute condition, and any playback will stop. Pressing the **MUTE/PAUSE** button again cancels the 90 minute sleep timer. Recording is completely unaffected by the sleep timer.

#### STEREO RECORDING

Your CCRecorder is factory set to record talk radio. If you want to record in stereo you must press the **VOL NORM** button for one second prior to recording. You will see a small stereo indicator light (in the upper right side of the numeric display region). When recording voice talk radio, mono setting should be used. Stereo setting will greatly reduce available recording space on the hard drive.

#### RECORDING WITH BUILT-IN MIC.

To record from the built-in microphone, press-and-hold the **RECORD** button, then press the **MIC** button. Be sure to record more than 2 seconds because if you wish to erase you must hold down the **VOL NORM** button for 2 seconds while the event is playing.

To stop the recording, press-and-hold the **RECORD** button again.

To playback your recording, simply push **PLAYBACK** button. When you press **PLAYBACK** the CCRecorder will find the most recent recording and play it back. When finished it will continue to search for events in **IMMED.** until the next one is found. To stop **PLAYBACK**, press **PLAY-BACK** again.

## RECORDING FROM AN EXTERNAL AUDIO SOURCE -

Plug the supplied patch cord into the headphone-out jack of a radio, (or other device). Plug the other end into the CCRecorder's jack labeled **'RADIO LINE IN**'. You can then hear the radio playing through the CCRecorder's built-in speaker. Position the radio about four feet away from the CCRecorder (and computers, etc.) to reduce radio noise.

Adjust the radio's volume to be moderately loud. Thereafter, you can adjust the listening volume using the CCRecorder's' control panel buttons marked **VOL UP, VOL NORM, VOL DN**. The **MUTE** button can be used if you desire complete silence.

Press and hold the **RECORD** button until the red record light comes on. Then, to begin a recording, press any of the 8 Sessions: **A, B, C, D, E, F, G,** or **IMMED.** The red **RECORD** light will flash when the recording is being made. The **MUTE** button does not effect recording.


Two events can be programmed for each session button, by using the **Break** and **Resume** functions as **Start**, and **End** times. Up to 16 events can be recorded using this method (2 events in each of the 8 sessions). There is no time limit for each event.

You will hear the hard disk spin-up momentarily when you leave the **SETUP** mode as the new setup is saved to disk.

# AUTO PLAYBACK/ALARM \_\_\_\_\_

While in **PRO** mode press the **SETUP** key, then press one of the session buttons repeatedly. To set Auto Playback ON time ,(indicated by

all four red lights on, See figure). Adjust the display to read the time you desire automatic playback to begin using the FWD >> and BACK << keys, make sure to set AM or PM and DAYS TO RECORD (which is also Days to Auto



ALL FOUR lights ON/OFF

Playback). Auto Playback will begin with your most recent recorded event, and will chain to playback all events, depending upon how long the Auto Playback is allowed to continue. The Auto Playback time must be the same number of minutes as the record time or the unit will cycle until an **END** time is found. Add your exact record time to determine your exact playback time.

While displaying the Auto Playback OFF Time, (indicated by all 4 red lights off), adjust the display to read the time you desire Auto Playback to end using the FWD >> and BACK << keys, make sure to set AM or PM and DAYS TO RECORD (which is also Days to Auto Playback). To set the Auto playback ON or Alarm ON, to playback at your programmed time, with the CCRecorder idle, press-and-hold session A button. The display must read "AL ON", for the Auto Playback to be active. To disable the Auto Playback or Alarm Off, press-and-hold session A button with the CCRecorder idle until "AL Off" is displayed. You cannot record and playback at the same time. Your most recent action takes precedence over any timed recording or playback programmed into the unit.

Press C, RESUME light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 11:35.

Press ADJUST button, set A (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press C, END light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 12:00.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **P** (for PM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

While in Setup mode you can delete a record time by holding the **DAYS TO RECORD** button, until display reads **0:00A**.

#### Set Automatic Playback Time

Press **A**, until all lights **BEGIN** through **END** are on, Press **FWD** >> until display reads **6:00** to set Start Playback time.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **P** (for PM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press **A**, all lights **BEGIN** through **END** are off, Press **FWD** >> until display reads **8:30** to set End Playback time.

Press ADJUST button, set P (for PM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press **SETUP** button, until yellow light is off. Display will show **A1**.

Note: Playback can be set under any session button. The playback duration must be the same number of minutes as the record time or the unit will cycle until an "**END**" time is found. Add your exact record time programmed into each session to determine playback needed. In our example it is 150 mins. or 2-1/2 hours.

## Set Auto playback to come on

With the CCRecorder idle, press-and-hold session **A** button until display reads **AL ON**.

The CCRecorder is now set to playback at our designated times.

CCRecorder is idle. To initialize your CCRecorder press the **RECORD** button until the red light stays on. Your CCRecorder will now record automatically from 9:05 AM to 12:00 PM and record into sessions A, B, and C. Be sure your radio is on and plugged into the CCRecorder.

Note: We put each hour into a separate session to cut out the commercials. The CCRecorder will automatically chain the events on playback. You can also select which hour of the show you would like to listen to manually with this method by selecting each session button during playback.

Recording will continue until you press-and-hold the **RECORD** button again, until the disk is full or a programmed "end time" has been reached. Be sure to record more than 2 seconds because if you wish to erase you must hold down the **VOL NORM** button for 2 seconds while the event is playing.

In each of the separate Sessions, labeled **A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**, **F**, **G**, and **IMMED**, the CCRecorder stores up to 15 events. All events in the sessions are accessible at any time during playback, by pressing the **A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**, **F**, **G**, or **IMMED**. buttons multiple times during playback, to access older recordings (or events).

#### PLAYBACK

When you press **PLAYBACK** the CCRecorder will attempt to find the most recent event in Session **A**. If nothing is recorded it will continue to search sessions **B** through **G** until an event is found. To stop **PLAYBACK**, press **PLAYBACK** again.

To loop an individual recording to playback continuously--On the recording you wish to loop, quickly press the **PLAYBACK** button 2 times while playback is being performed. The display will read "**Loop**". When the recording is finished, it will start at the beginning of the individual recording and repeat until you push the **PLAYBACK** button again 2 times and the display reads "**Unloop**".

To hear older events in a Session, press A, B, C, D, E, F, G or IMMED. buttons multiple times in rapid succession. The most recent recorded event plays first. The 15 event levels are numbered as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, A, b, C, d, E, F. During playback, the number of the event is shown at the far right side of the numeric display.


To fast scan the event use the **BACK** << or **FWD** >> buttons to advance in 60 second increments. To scan in slower 10 second increments use the dual purpose keys <<**ADJUST** button and the **DAYS TO RECORD>>** button. If you scan beyond the current event, playback will chain quickly to the next session.

# RECORDING WITH QUICK SETUP CODES.

Refer to the following code listings for recording specific times of radio programs. Codes for your **favorite talkshow host** are shown on the next page. Should your radio program not be mentioned by name there, please refer to the extensive code lists, for the time of the radio show you wish to record or use a **Custom Setup** time explained on page 24 of this manual.

How to enter a Quick Setup Code: Press session E Button for Easy mode before beginning. Enter Quick Setup Codes from this mode.

Press the "QUICK SETUP" button to begin. Notice the yellow light by the QUICK SETUP button has turned on. Wait until the numeric display shows a single digit of zero:"0"



From the following code lists, select the Quick Setup Code that is appropriate for the days-of week and the time of the radio program you wish to record. The codes consist of several of the lettered keys **A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**, **F**, **G**, and **IMMED**. Enter the code letters by pressing the corresponding keys, one key at a time.

The display will show a Confirming Number, which needs to match the **Conf.** # from your **Quick Setup code**. If the Confirming Number is not correct, press the recorder's **MUTE** button to clear the code and clear the display to zero (0), then re-enter the code letters one button at a time, and check the Confirming Number. When the Confirming Number is correct, proceed to the next step.

Press the **QUICK SETUP** button again to complete. The yellow light by the **QUICK SETUP** button will turn off, the hard disk inside the CCRecorder will "spin-up" briefly to save the new Quick Setup Code, and the display will show a confirming message, "**Code Has Been Set**." That completes the actual Quick Setup.

Now your CCRecorder is "idle" again, merely displaying the current time. Finally, press-and-hold **RECORD** button until light stays on to set your CCRecorder for automatic recording. Be sure your radio is on, set to the station you will be recording from, and plugged into the CCRecorder.

To clear ALL of your previous **Quick Setup Codes** and **Custom Time Record Setup**, while in **Quick Setup Mode**, press session buttons **C**, and **A**, your confirming number is **5**.

With the CCRecorder idle, press-and-hold, session F button until display reads ".**Pro**".

Press **SETUP** button until yellow light stays on.

Press session A button (or any button A thru G or IMMED.).

Press DAYS TO RECORD and select MON-FRI.

**BEGIN** light is on, Press **FWD** >> to run clock to display **9:05**.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **A** (for AM).

Press A, BREAK light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 9:30.

Press ADJUST button, set A (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press A, RESUME light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 9:35.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **A** (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press A, END light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 10:00.

Press ADJUST button, set A (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press session **B** button.

Press DAYS TO RECORD and select MON-FRI.

**BEGIN** light is on, Press **FWD** >> until display reads **10:05**.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **A** (for AM).

Press B, BREAK light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 10:30.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **A** (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press B, RESUME light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 10:35.

Press ADJUST button, set A (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press B, END light is on, Press FWD >> until display reads 11:00.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **A** (for AM).

Press DAYS TO RECORD to select MON-FRI.

Press session C button.

Press DAYS TO RECORD and select MON-FRI.

**BEGIN** light is on, Press **FWD** >> until display reads **11:05**.

Press **ADJUST** button, set **A** (for AM).





## CUSTOM RECORD TIME SETUP

The **Pro**fessional mode allows you to customize record times. To enter **Pro**fessional mode, have the Recorder idle, then press-and-hold the "**F Pro**" button for about 3 seconds until the displays shows ".**Pro**" The small light along the bottom left of the numeric display stays on to indicate **Pro** mode. (This is the same light for 90 min. sleep timer, 90 min. sleep timer will activate if set in either **Pro** or **EASY** mode).





#### **Custom Record Time Setup**

Example: Set to record a show Mon-Fri from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM.

With the CCRecorder idle, Press and hold session **F** button until display reads ".**Pro**".

Press SETUP, (above), button until yellow light stays on.

Press session A button (or any button A thru G or IMMED.).

Press DAYS TO RECORD button, and select MON-FRI.

Set **BEGIN** time by using **FWD** >> and **BACK** << buttons until display reads 2:00.

Press ADJUST button, set P (for PM).

Press session A button several times until END light is on.

Press DAYS TO RECORD button, and select MON-FRI.

Set End time by using FWD>> and BACK<< until display reads 3:00.

Press ADJUST button, set P (for PM) .

Press **SETUP** button until yellow light goes out. Display will show **A1**. To initialize your CCRecorder press the **RECORD** button until the red light stays on. Your CCRecorder will now turn on automatically from **2:00 to 3:00 PM** and record into session **A**. Be sure your radio is on and plugged into the CCRecorder.

## Advanced Custom Record Time Setup

Example: Set to record from 9:05 AM to 12:00 PM (noon) Mon-Fri, and eliminate most commercials. Also we will playback the program automatically at 6:00 PM daily when I get home. (Early day!)
