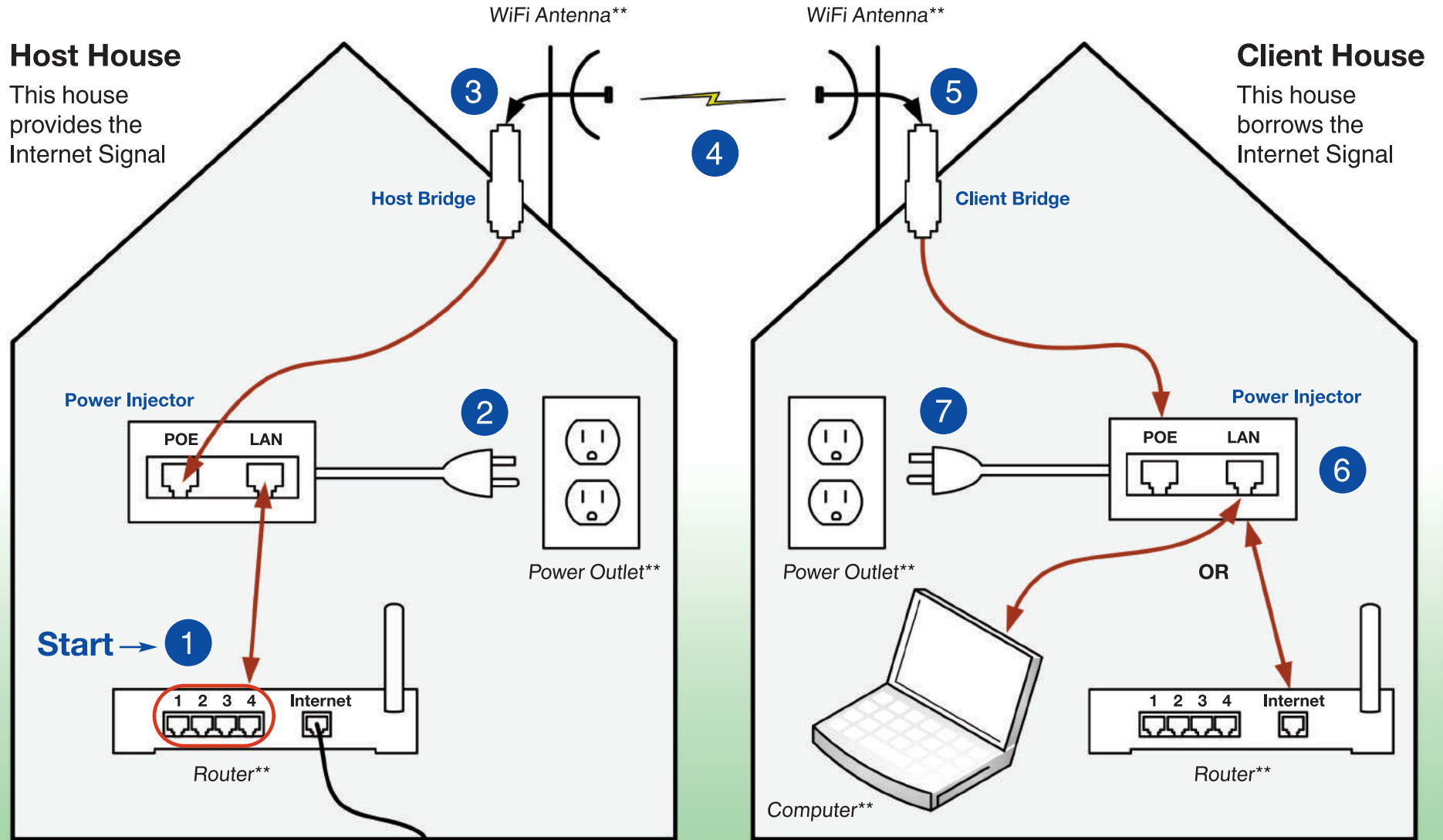


Long Range WiFi Bridge System Connection Diagram
